Dear brethren,

I trust this finds you in victory and filled with the joy of the Lord which I remind us is our strength. You have been such a blessing to us and the ministry as you pray and support us in this work of God. There was not enough time or resources to produce a full newsletter before leaving, so I am writing to give you a brief mission update and let you know how to pray for our upcoming trip and current needs. My schedule is very busy through most of April so I may not get a full newsletter out until sometime before (Lord Willing) our largest trip of the year planned for June-July.

We praise God for helping us on our last evangelism tour to Florida in January. God has done great things. We were able to attend some of the Sun City campmeeting services when not on the road in FL. As a mission help we preached in a park in Ft. Pierce, FL to homeless people, in two services at Ft. Myers Rescue Mission, and at the Bible Methodist Church in Pinellas Park, FL who is presently in need of a pastor. We also held mission services at Sun City FL campmeeting; in a Hobe Sound Bible College chapel service; at the Ebenezer Holiness Baptist Church in Columbia SC where Rev. Ken Walter now pastors, and were asked to give a brief mission presentation at Camp Freedom in St. Petersburg, FL while visiting there.

There were also opportunities to evangelize on the streets and as we traveled from place to place. There was a man saved during one of the outreaches at Ft. Pierce. While at Ft. Myers Rescue Mission I was able to hold two biblical counseling sessions with two of the residents. These men were hungry for help and direction in their lives. To God be Glory for all that has been done for His Kingdom on our last trip.

Its hard to believe, but its time to soon leave again for phase two of our visit to Florida this year. Our major focus on our Feb/March trip is to help several small churches in Florida and some in Alabama. Pray for souls to be won and the brethren to be strengthened. We start our trip by speaking about our mission vision and our mission based helps for small churches in one of the afternoon services at the Pilgrim Nazarene Church's "Preachers Meeting" which is their annual ministerial held this year in Pell City, AL. Lord willing we will be doing evangelism & outreach in nearby areas as well as speaking in some of the churches we help with outreach. Lord willing my mother and daughter will be along on this journey. Pray for Gabrielle as she helps minister in some places. If much is accomplished it will come through those who really intercede for us and the mission work in prayer!

My trips have always been a by faith adventure and this one is no different. By God's hand within one year we have driven all the way to CA, TX, SD, TN, and FL in five separate trips all for the sake of evangelizing the lost. By faith in God He provided for each trip one step at a time. He has always met the needs. To God Be All The Glory! This trip is a bit like the one to SD where there are very few presently scheduled deputation services. On that SD trip God brought most of the funds in to make the journey through mail-in and a few online contributions. We are trusting the Lord to meet all the needs as we go in Jesus name to rescue the lost.
