We have distributed thousands of Gospel tracts, hundreds of sermon CD/DVDs, and many Bibles. We prayed with many people on the streets, counseled people in person and over the phone, as well as preached many services in churches and some open air preaching. To God be all the Glory for the souls that were saved, and the brethren that were encouraged to win the lost.

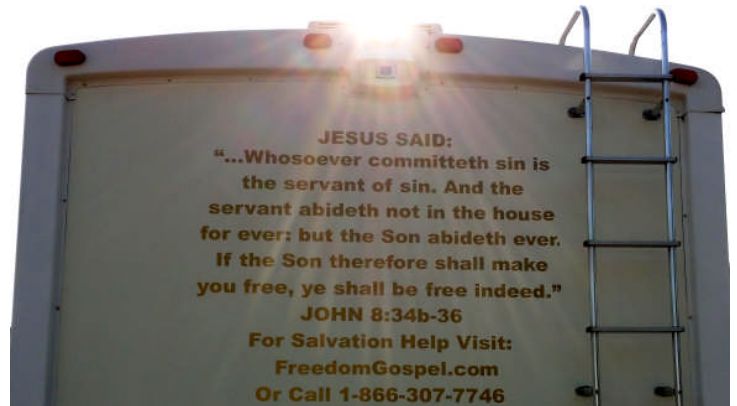

## God's Blessing on His Word to reach the Lost!

By the leading of God, I contacted a brother in Arizona who can make vinyl lettering about a sign God wanted on the back of our motorhome. So with my layout plans, he cut the vinyl on his machine and mailed the lettering to me. I also had him make lettering to represent our mission to be placed on the sides of the motorhome. I installed the lettering on the back of our motorhome and some on the one side. Now as people pass by me on the highway, or when parked, they get God's Word to help them find salvation along with a phone number and website where they can get help. Look at this picture the Lord led me to take the next day. Even though I had so much to do before service as I was to preach in just a few hours, I was compelled by the Lord that morning to take time to take pictures. When I got outside to the back of the motorhome, I quickly learned it was the exact time that the sun



was straight over the motorhome. The SONshine sent flares through the camera lens. When I saw what showed up on the picture, God spoke to my heart that this was HIS blessing upon His Holy Word. Praise God for His Word going forth across the USA. Praise God for His awesome leading! Not only did this blessing of the Lord warm my heart to know God's leading for the mobile billboard was clearly His, but God has planted a new seed in my heart through this experience. This seed is to encourage scripture signs to be planted across the USA on private land.

Here is the idea the Lord gave me and I ask you to pray and see if God can use your land and resources to make it happen. If you or someone you know has land along a busy street, road, or highway, let's put up signs with scriptures like the one above, including a toll free help line and a website where people can find tracts to read and sermons to listen to. If a sign is not advertising a specific church, and is a Scripture message to the community, it should be freedom of speech and no permit needed like advertising signs require (this should be verified for your community.) It should not be hard to make or too costly either. If interested; please contact me for suggestions or plans to make it happen.

## June-July Evangelism Mission Tour across the USA

Our first mission stop was the Great Commission Camp from June 24-27. Thank the Lord for all the young people who got saved and helped evangelize the streets. Here is a picture of one of the three groups that went out on the streets with us. There was a lady planning to commit suicide who came to one of the teens for help. Thank God we were on the streets and this lady changed her mind after talking with one of the young people about God! It was so wonderful to see young people



and adults encouraged to win souls! Pray for those encountered and those who ministered.

Then Gabi and I traveled to Urbana and Decatur Illinois to represent the mission. Then we went to Wauneta, NE to represent the mission and give the Too Many Masters sermon.

On July 2nd we arrived in Federal Heights, CO (Denver suburb) to help a mission church. While there we did downtown street evangelism in Denver, took part in a free community picnic they held, and did the Too Many Masters sermon where many children prayed for salvation. Pray for the Children who sought the Lord and this mission church.

Gabi was with me on this whole tour until July 8th when she flew to Baltimore, MD. There she got a ride to Hanover, PA to work in the GMC Kid's Camp. I sure miss her when she is not there. Gabi has been such a blessing and has been growing spiritually and is answering the call of the Lord to ministry. She has left her part time job and is now helping me more regularly. I need help so much. Please pray we can accomplish all the Lord is leading us to do. She will be 18 in December and a senior at Penn View Christian Academy this school year. As a call from the Lord normally means a call to prepare, she plans to start taking college classes during her high school senior year in addition to her high school studies. Pray we can get all the tuition paid for her to be able to return to school this fall and be able to get her into some Bible college classes at Penn View too.

On July 9th I drove to Lakewood, CO (Denver suburb,) where I shared about catching a vision for the lost and about our mission work. From there I took the motorhome across the Denver area to Littleton, CO (another Denver suburb.) There I did some training and door to door evangelism with them on Saturday and preached the "Too Many Masters" sermon Sunday morning. We thank the Lord for the hearts that were encouraged: in their faith and to reach the lost.

On Tuesday July 15th, I left the Denver area and headed to Texhoma, OK. In Texhoma I helped a missions church. There we held three nights of an evangelism convention and did local community evangelism/outreach for a couple of days. On Saturday evening I gave my testimony, Sunday morning preached the AM service, and then Sunday night preached the Too Many Masters sermon. Praise God for all He has done! Pray for this mission church, souls that were reached with the Gospel, a young man who got himself in severe trouble, and their youth to be gloriously SAVED!

This trip had many great spiritual blessings for many souls and myself, but it was a very trying experience physically as my back problems flared up again. I have several severe disc problems in my back and need God's healing touch again. If it's not God's will to heal me, please pray I find a good doctor who can be proactive in helping me find the best solution for my continued chronic back problems.

Lord willing, I leave on Tuesday Aug. 5th to evangelize the streets during the annual MusikFest in Bethlehem, PA. There will be drunkenness on the streets and people need God! Pray for us as we minister on the streets near the event and for my back to be strong enough to handle the work alone, or better yet that some would come to help! There are over 1.5 million people that visit a city of normally 75,000. I'm desperately looking for volunteers to come help evangelize the streets. I also plan to stay for some of Elim Grove Campmeeting with David Fulton and the Tim & Amy Cooley Family. Pray for the campmeeting starting on Aug. 8.

Then the Lord Willing, our plan is the last weekend of August will be a time to help a small church in Berwick, PA. There we will do a lot of outreach. There will be a guest speaker sharing about evangelism and evangelistic sermons on Sunday. Pray for souls to be won and if you can, come and help. Then the first weekend of Sept is time for the annual tractor show outreach at Penns Cave for 4 days. Pray as we will have a prayer stand booth set-up to reach the lost and that there would many volunteers.

Lord Willing, from Sept-Dec, Gabi and I will be focusing much on campus evangelism and encouraging the new evangelism club at Penn View to help reach the lost. There is the possibility of setting up at some local events too. In Oct. I'll be heading to OH and IN for a short mission trip and in Nov. possibly TX, OK, and LA. Then Lord willing, a southern trip this winter to SC & FL and maybe more. Please pray for these efforts to win souls, help churches, and train soul winners.

## Mission Housing Project

With Gabi and I away from home for most of the summer, we have prepared our living space upstairs for the missionary family I told you about in previous writings. The Greg Davis family are college campus missionaries and have been living in their camper for years as they minister all over the USA. They were the first missionaries to use the house besides us. As God leads and we further develop the building, I'm sure God will send more missionaries to stay there. Here are some pictures of the upstairs area that was prepared for them. In



addition to the areas pictured they had the upstairs kitchen & bathroom, and the downstairs living room that I also use as a counseling area.

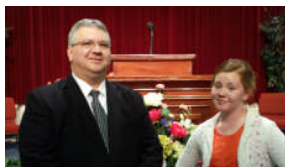
