Dear Ministry Partners,

Isn't it crazy that it's spring already? It feels like summer is just around the corner! Since the last time I wrote to you all, God has worked in the Indianapolis area!

In February I started a ministry called Seek and Find through the mission department at Union Bible College. The object is to seek out those who are physically and spiritually hungry and help them find Jesus. Our goal is to go to the inner city of Indianapolis once a month as long as we have more than myself able to go, since I've been advised not to go alone.

So, how does Seek and Find work? I'm glad you asked! We package sack lunches to distribute to homeless people, and then we head downtown! Once we give them the food, we ask them what their favorite scripture is. We read the verse(s) they request, or in the case they do not have a favorite scripture, we choose one of our own and read it. Once we read the scripture to them, we explain its meaning and relate it to the Gospel. Sharing the plan of salvation to them, we ask if they want to give their life to Christ. The very first man we encountered had was in his mid-50s. I read one of Jesus' parables to him and explained to him the amazing news of the Gospel. Much to my surprise, this man in his mid-50s who lives in a Christian nation has never heard the Gospel before. He told me that it sounded wonderful and he would like to experience it. We had prayer with him and he gave his heart to Jesus! Can you imagine a man living in the US who is nearing 60 years old never hearing of the Gospel? I encourage you to do what you can to share Jesus with others. People are starving for truth, but we need the eyes of God to see them and His leading to help them.



Later that afternoon, Cesia and I met another man who was on fire for God. We shared and discussed scripture with each other and had prayer. As we walked by him later, we heard him sharing his testimony with other homeless people on the street. Isn't it awesome that God's people are everywhere, and He uses them exactly where they are?

The Lord willing, I am hopeful to graduate from Union Bible College on May 24th. I'm a little sad my time at UBC is over, but excited about what the future holds. I've mentioned before I felt God leading me to get a degree in social work but was unsure of the timing. Upon my graduation I plan on taking some time off from college, going

on mission trips, working in the mission office, and helping at churches in PA. I'm very excited where God is going to lead and am still praying about my future plans. Please join me in praying that God will lead me closer to him so that I can discern his will in each step I take! I also want to thank all of those who have prayed and/or financially supported my college journey!

This summer I am going on two mission trips, one domestic and one foreign. In June I am going to Utah with my dad and in July I am going to Ukraine. Both trips are events I am very much looking forward to! God has provided all the funds needed for my Ukraine trip and I give Him praise and thank each of you who allowed Him to use you in helping to fund this trip! The Ukraine mission team just had a meeting a few days ago going over the schedule for the trip. It looks like each one of the team members will have at least a brief time to share scripture and discuss it during the youth camp we will be at. I'm looking forward to what God has in store! I still need to raise some money for my Utah mission trip in June and ask that you would help me pray about this need, and if you are able to contribute, I would greatly appreciate it! I am so looking forward to doing street meetings in Salt Lake City and personal evangelism while we are there! We also hope to receive more Mormon evangelism training in Ephraim, UT, as well as do evangelism during the outdoor play, Mormon Miracle Pageant, in Manti, UT.

The trips are approaching fast. I am so grateful for all the funds that came in for my Ukraine trip. Please help me pray that the funds come in for my Salt Lake City trip too. I still need to raise approximately \$600. Since I will no longer be working at Teen Challenge as of May 29th, I will have my summer support and general expenses to raise for June & July. I will be working only for the mission now. The support funds I need to raise are approximately \$2000 and includes: salary, newsletters, travel, times of evangelism, and some new things that will be announced in my next newsletter. Please pray and support how you are led by the Lord.

God has plans much bigger than we could ever imagine!
