The last two places that I went to were Watford City, North Dakota and Milwaukee, Wisconsin. We were invited to conduct evangelistic services in Watford City by a Mrs. Haugen who had gotten heavily involved in what is known as the “Conservative Holiness Movement” through various livestreamed church services, if my understanding is correct. Mrs. Haugen’s passion is to see a conservative holiness church planted in her city. Anyway, we found Watford City to be a rapidly growing city in the middle of the Bakken Oil Fields that is filled with people who were surprisingly open and welcoming to our



ministry efforts. We built friendships with several Christians that claimed to be seeking a deeper relationship with God. I trust that we were able to encourage the more than 25 different people that came to our evangelistic services besides the Haugens and us workers. Our time in Watford City was spent doing door to door invitations to the evangelistic services and passing out tracts, some bar ministry, a small amount of street preaching, conducting Bible Teaching in mid-morning sessions, and as mentioned, evangelistic services in the evening. I learned in Chicago that my efforts must be solely for the Glory of God, because often times outward results/successes will not be tangibly seen. In Watford City, I discovered an example of souls that are truly ripe for harvest. There are people there that are truly crying out for a way to live above sin. I am equally happy to report that there are plans to plant a holiness church in that area, and as far as I know, a holiness organization is currently in progress of doing so. Lastly, in Milwaukee, I saw firsthand the power in the name of Jesus Christ to overcome evil. Ultimately, I am thankful to Jesus Christ for His faithfulness to me.
