After we headed to the car, a couple came up to us and began a conversation with my dad. The man was a drug addict and decided that he wasn't going to do any drugs in front of his girlfriend. It then dawned on him that God is everywhere and even if he was hiding his drug addiction, God would see it. So he decided if he could stop doing drugs around his girlfriend, he would promise God every day that he wouldn't do drugs in front of Him! Through this method, he stayed clean from cocaine for 8 days. Pray for him to be completely delivered. My dad witnessed to him and they prayed together.

My dad and I met up with Erik Samborski in Wilkes-Barre to hold a street meeting on May 26. All three of us sang during the street meeting and my dad and Erik preached. God's presence was definitely felt and two people prayed for salvation!
