Late July-August and Mission Trip 80

The end of July through August was spent in Salt Lake City, UT (SLC) and on Mission Trip 80 to Arcadia & Hollywood, CA.

Salt Lake City (SLC)

Mission Trip 80

This trip was to Arcadia, CA. It was great to be with Bro. Matthew Brewer and his wife at the Wesleyan Holiness Church. Prior to arriving in Arcadia, I worked remotely with Sister Brewer to develop a brand new Facebook page and ads for the events. We did a large door-to-door evangelism event, canvased the area

We did one service in the park and the Brewers sang and preached and I led the service. I also spoke in their Sunday evening service. We were glad to see people attend 📙 the events. I also did tract evangelism in the park another evening.


Also please pray I'm able to get another SUV this April when I'm home in PA. My little Honda CRV is maxed out towing this

At the conference, I represented our mission work connecting with bible college ministerial students and displaying our latest recruiting banner.

It was so awesome to see Bro. Malik Evegan there (picture right). For those who don't know, Malik got saved in downtown Cincinnati when I talked and prayed with him during our street meeting. That was in the Spring of 2023 and by the Fall he started attending GBSC. Praise God he is serv-



ing the Lord and studying for the ministry. This was an exciting day! Another wonderful thing Malik shared with me, is that his sister just got saved the week before the conference. When I asked him if he knew what area of ministry he was called to, he said he feels led to preach. I asked: like pastoring? Then he shared, as a "street preacher." PRAISE GOD!!! I invited him to join our mission. Let's see where God takes him. Please pray for Malik and his Charge to Keep and Calling to Fulfill!

It was also so good to see Bryan Witt there too. He was our IT Manager for over 1.5 years. He asked me if there were any good places to do street ministry nearby. I told him about Birmingham and suggested some places they could go. Bryan then organized and led an evangelism event in the park in Birmingham, AL. If I remember correctly there were 16 on the bus. Our mission supplied them with thousands of gospel tracts. He has always been good at getting GBS students to join us on the streets when I'm in Cincinnati.

Bryan is off to new endeavors now. He resigned as our IT Manager just before the Fall semester because the level of work was going to be too much now that he is a dual major through GBSC as a ministerial student and studying computers through GBSC interlinking college connections.
